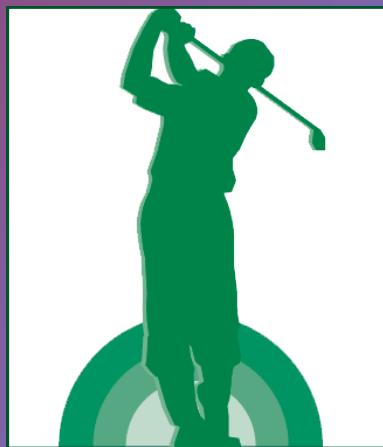


Announcing the Biggest (Non-Competitive) Contest EVER!!! PART DEUX

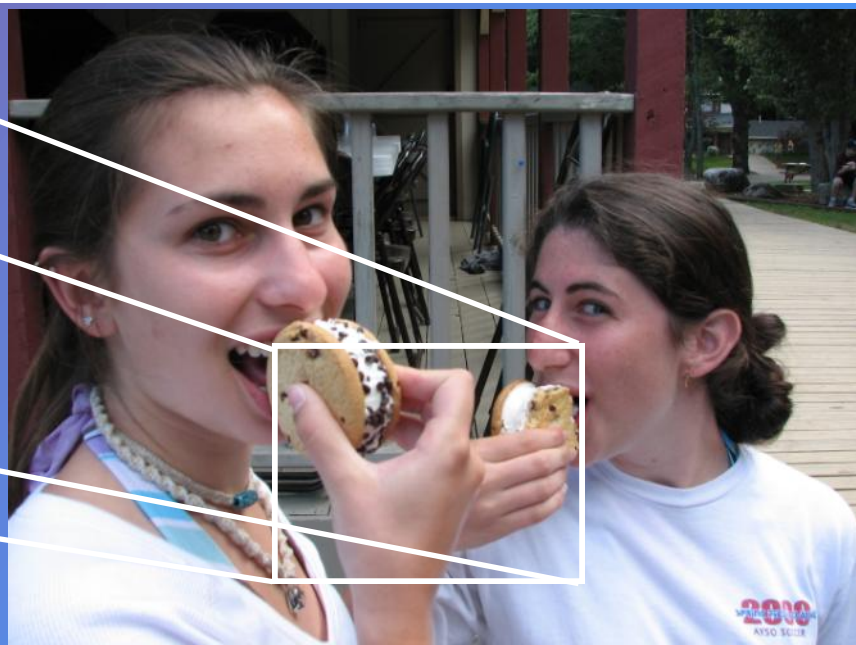

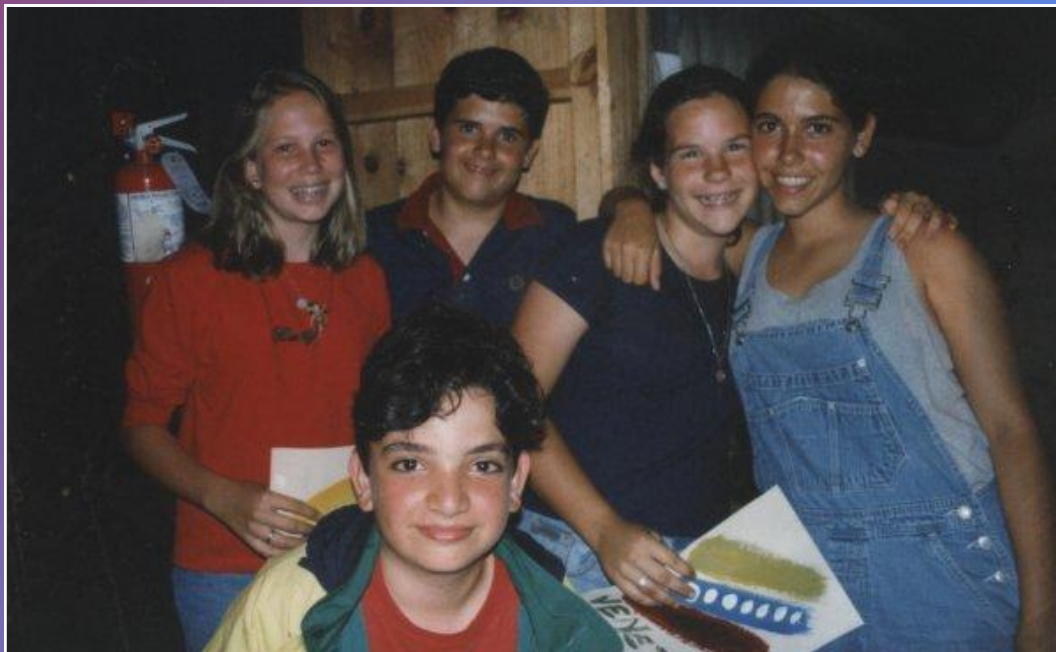
